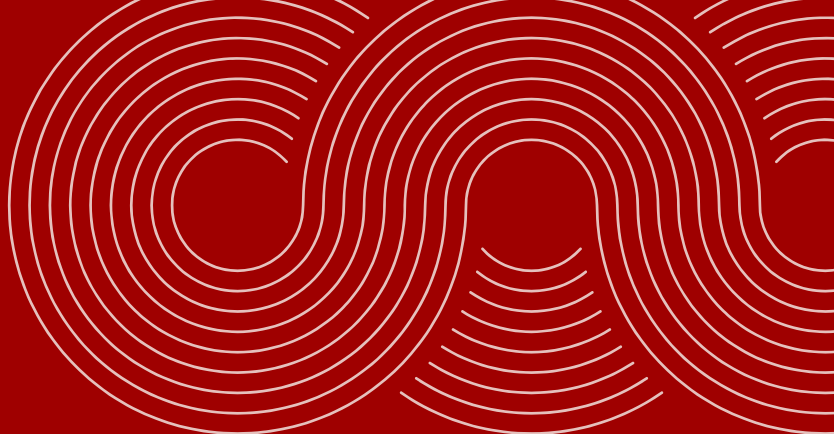

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FROM THE CHAIRMAN

My Dear Professional Colleagues,

Warm Greetings!

Every year, 1st July occupies a special place in the hearts of every Chartered Accountant. It is a day etched in our memories as the Foundation Day of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (ICAI)—our alma mater and the institution to which we proudly belong.

On 1st July 1949, ICAI came into existence through an Act of Parliament. Over the past 78 glorious years, the Institute has grown by leaps and bounds, both in terms of its members and student fraternity. Today, ICAI stands as the second-largest accounting body in the world, serving the profession, industry, government, and society with unwavering commitment, competence, and integrity.

ICAI is unique among professional institutions across the globe. It performs the multifaceted roles of education, examination, admission to membership, continuing professional education, standard-setting, and regulation of the profession through its disciplinary mechanism. Few professional bodies in the world enjoy the intellectual strength and statutory recognition that ICAI does. It is indeed a matter of immense pride that our Institute was aptly described as a "Partner in Nation Building" by the visionary former President of India, Dr. A. P. J. Abdul Kalam.

The journey of ICAI is deeply rooted in history. The foundation of the profession was laid through the deliberations during the 1930s and 1940s. The first significant initiative commenced with the discussions on the Companies (Amendment) Bill on 23rd March 1936. The profession was initially recognized under the Companies Act, 1913, followed by the establishment of the Accountancy Board in 1932, culminating in the formation of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India on
